Children under the age of 12 must not have access to the pantry, cookhouse or the terrace and steps behind the cookhouse. Children aged 12-14 must be supervised and a risk assessment carried out depending on the job they are undertaking. Continued...		

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continued	Kitchen personnel by Burns/Scalds- personal injury or death continued	<p>14-18 year olds can assist in this area, but a risk assessment should be in place.</p> <p>Any adults felt to be in need of supervision in those areas should have a risk assessment put in place or taken to safety away from the area.</p> <p>Once last hot drinks/ meals have been served, preferably no later than 10pm, allow the trench oven to go out. Socialising to be moved to the dining room.</p>		
continued	Kitchen personnel by Slipping/Tripping- personal injury or death	<p>Area kept grease and obstacle free</p> <p>Cooking Area restricted to Kitchen Staff only.</p> <p>Physical barrier across front open entrance to Cooking Area to prevent unnecessary entry.</p> <p>Ensure Cooking Aids and utensils are in good condition.</p> <p>Continued...</p>
